We Have Zero Tolerance To

- Ragging.
- Crime against Women.
- Alcohol, Smoking, Chewing Tobacco, Ghutka etc.

- Possession or use of hallucinogenic drugs in the campus.
- Possession or use of alcoholic beverage of delinquency under the influence of alcohol.
- Use of cell phones other than specified zone in the campus.
- Bringing of Outsiders in the Premises.

Students found accused of such act by the way of indulging inside or outside the college premises shall be liable to punishment as per the guidelines given by UGC in the light of Hon'ble Supreme Court Directions. The possible punishment shall be anyone or the combination of the following :-

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Suspension/withdrawing of Scholarship and other financial benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in examination and other evaluation process.
- debarring from representing the institution in any intra-college/inter-college/inter-university/international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension and rustication from the college.
- Cancellation of Admission.
- Special Fine depending upon the gravity of the offence
- Collective Punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of Ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

Note : The cases pertaining to the Ragging will be reported to the police and will be dealt as per Himachal Pradesh Education Institution (Prohibition of Ragging) Act 2009 according to which Ragging has been declared as a 'Cognizable and Non-bailable Offence'. Any student convicted of Ragging related offence will be punished with the imprisonment of upto 3 years or fine of Rs.50,000 or both.

ADMISSION RULES & ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

The Minimum qualification prescribed for admission to the courses and examination leading to the degree course of the university shall be in accordance with the first ordinance of HP University 1973 (clause 1.4 Chapter-1) Any student who is seeking admission in the college in any Faculty / Course has to fulfill the following eligibility condition/Rules (clause 3.3A of Chapter III Vol.1) of the Ordinance of HP University.

A. Academic Qualification

BA-1st Semester-(Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.A.-1st Semester (Pass Course) the candidate should have passed:

- (I) 10+2 examination or an equivalent examination from any recognized Board/university established by law in India with 4 written subjects (Including English) with at least 33% marks.

भारत के किसी भी मान्यता प्राप्त बोर्ड/विश्वविद्यालय से न्यूनतम 33% अंकों के साथ 10+2 अथवा समकक्ष परीक्षा

अंग्रेजी सहित चार विषयों में उत्तीर्ण।

OR

- (II) Intermediate examination of Indian University/Board or any examination recognised equivalent thereto (pass in four subjects, one language and three other elective) with at least 33% marks.

किसी भी मान्यता प्राप्त बोर्ड/विश्वविद्यालय से न्यूनतम 33 अंकों के साथ इंटरमीडिएट (मध्यवर्ती) परीक्षा

किसी एक भाषा सहित चार विषयों में उत्तीर्ण।

- (III) For admission to BA-I with mathematics, either 45% marks in aggregate (with maths) or 45% in mathematics at 10+2 level, is eligible for admission to BA-1Semester.

गणित के साथ पाठ्यक्रम के लिए 10+2 में गणित विषय में 45% अंक अथवा गणित विषय के साथ 45: कुल अंक।

B.Com-1st Semester (Pass Course)

To be eligible for seeking admission to B.com-1st Semester (pass course) the candidate should have passed:

- (I) 10+2 examination (commerce stream) with minimum 40% are eligible for admission in 1st Semester of the course.

10+2 में वाणिज्य विषय के साथ न्यूनतम 40% कुल अंक।

OR

- (II) A student who has passed +2 or equivalent exams other than commerce stream in four written subjects (including English) with Economics or Mathematics as compulsory subject at +2 level with 45% marks is eligible for admission in 1st Semester of the course.

जिन विद्यार्थियों ने 10+2 अथवा समकक्ष परीक्षा वाणिज्य विषय के साथ नहीं उत्तीर्ण की है, ऐसे विद्यार्थी 10+2 में न्यूनतम 45% कुल अंकों के साथ उत्तीर्ण होने चाहिए, लेकिन इन विद्यार्थियों को अपनी 10+2 परीक्षा अंग्रेजी विषय के साथ अर्थशास्त्र अथवा गणित विषय के साथ उत्तीर्ण होना भी अनिवार्य है।

- (III) For girl candidate the eligibility is pass percentage i.e. 33%

छात्राओं के लिए उपरोक्त शर्तों के अतिरिक्त न्यूनतम उत्तीर्ण प्रतिशत 33% है।

Remarks :-

While determining percentage of marks for eligibility, rounding off of fraction of 0.5 or above to the next full unit is permissible. A relaxation of 5% is available to SC/ST candidates for admission to B.Sc./B.Com 1st Semester.

पात्रता निर्धारित करने के लिए अंक प्रतिशतता निर्धारित करते समय 0.5 या इससे ऊपर के अंक के अंश को सम्पूर्ण इकाई माना जायेगा। अनुसूचित जाति व जनजाति के विद्यार्थियों के लिए बी.कॉम व बी.एस.सी. में प्रवेश पात्रता में 5% की छूट है।

Important Note :-

At any stage, if any student is found to claim his/her basic eligibility qualification from take or unrecognized Board/University, his/her admission shall stand automatically cancelled. The College shall not be responsible for cancellation such admissions.

B. Age Limit

For Admission to the 1st Semester of any course a student must not be more than 23 years (25 years for girls) of age as on 1st July 2026 e.g. the applicant should not be born earlier than 01-07-2003 in case of boys and 01-07-2001 in case of girls. However, in r/o SC and ST Students, a relaxation of 3 years is given.

The Vice-Chancellor of HPU Shimla has the power to permit age relaxation up to a maximum of 6 months. All such cases will be granted age relaxation provisionally up to six months by the Principal and a consolidated list of such cases will be sent for approval of the Vice-Chancellor by 31st October of every Academic Year. A candidate who has availed age relaxation at the time of first admission shall be eligible for the same in the subsequent classes also.

किसी भी पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश के लिए अधिकतम आयु सीमा 01 जुलाई 2026 को छात्रवर्ग के लिए 23 वर्ष (छात्रा वर्ग के लिए 25 वर्ष) से अधिक नहीं होनी चाहिए। अर्थात् छात्रों के सन्दर्भ में जन्मतिथि 01.07.2003 तथा छात्राओं के सन्दर्भ में जन्मतिथि 01.07.2001 से पहले की नहीं होनी चाहिए। यद्यपि अनुसूचित जाति व जनजाति के छात्र/छात्राओं को आयु सीमा में 3 वर्ष की छूट है। 6 महीने की अधिकतम आयु सीमा प्रदान करने की छूट की शक्ति उप कुलपति हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय को प्राप्त है। ऐसे सभी विद्यार्थियों को 6 महीने के लिए प्राचार्य द्वारा अस्थाई प्रवेश दिया जाएगा। ऐसे विद्यार्थियों की समेकित सूची प्रत्येक शैक्षणिक वर्ष के 31 अक्टूबर तक हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय के उपकुलपति के अुमोदन के लिए भेजी जाएगी। जिस विद्यार्थी ने प्रथम प्रवेश के लिए आयु छूट का लाभ उठाया है वह अगली कक्षाओं में भी आयु छूट के लिए पात्र होगा।

Registration and Migration

For registration to this university students have to apply online at

After applying online and payment of requisite fees, students have to submit hard copy of Registration Form with the following documents in college office:

1. Self-attested copy of Matric
2. Self-attested copy of 10+2
3. Original migration certificate

Directions for Migration

I. Open the registration portal <http://nrme.hpshimla.in/> click on student activity and choose inter-college migration.

II. Select your program type and enter your user ID and password (which you have received while filling the registration/examination form) then click on login.

III. Student details will be automatically fetched there, give the appropriate reason of migration and choose the college where candidate wants to migrate and then click on Apply, then note down your reference number.

IV. Your application will be sent to both colleges for approval through clerk and principal user ID.

V. Candidate can check his/her application status on the status section using reference number.

VI. After the approval of both colleges and university the payment option will be activated, then click on the payment and pay the migration fee rupees five hundred (Rs. 500.00) through online using credit card/Debit card and Net Banking. After successful completion of the payment candidate can download his/her inter-college migration certificate

Curriculum and Credit Framework (Semester System for UG Programs under NEP 2020: Academic Session 2026-27 Onward

The Government of Himachal Pradesh, Department of Higher Education, vide Notification No. EDUA-009/7/2025-278440-NEP dated 01 April 2026, and Himachal Pradesh University vide Letter No. 7- 1/2025-HPU(Acad) dated 18 April 2026, have notified the adoption of the latest course curriculum under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. With effect from the Academic Session 2026-27, the annual Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) under RUSA has been replaced by the semester system incorporating a multiple entry and exit framework. Admissions to the first semester of Undergraduate Programmes from the Academic Session 2026-27 onwards shall be governed by the new course curriculum. For detailed information regarding the revised curriculum, the Curriculum and Credit Framework Guidelines for Undergraduate Programmes under NEP 2020, issued by Himachal Pradesh University, are available on the university website.

Examination, Assessment and Grading System

Assessment Pattern

Each course shall be assessed through Internal Assessment (IA) conducted by the college and an End-Semester Examination (ESE) conducted by HPU. The weightage of IA and ESE shall be as per the syllabi / evaluation scheme notified by HPU for each course.

Internal Assessment shall include assignments, class tests, seminars, presentations, and practicals conducted on a continuous basis throughout the semester.

End-Semester Examinations shall be conducted by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, at the end of each semester.

Students must secure the minimum required marks/grades in IA, in ESE, and in the aggregate to pass a course, as prescribed by HPU.

Grading System

The HPU-UGP uses a Grade Point-based system. Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) shall be computed as per HPU norms. Letter Grades awarded are: O (Outstanding), A+ (Excellent), A (Very Good), B+ (Good), B (Above Average), C (Average), D (Pass), F (Fail).

Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) — Mandatory Registration

As per the HPU-UGP framework and UGC directives, registration on the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is mandatory for all students. The ABC is a national digital repository (abc.gov.in) that stores credits earned by each student across their academic journey, enabling credit transfer and mobility.

Every student admitted to this college for session 2026–27 must register on the ABC portal (abc.gov.in) using their Aadhaar number and generate their unique ABC ID.

ABC ID must be furnished at the time of examination registration. Credits earned at HPU will be deposited in the student's ABC account by the university.

The ABC facilitates seamless credit transfer if a student moves to another institution, and is the basis for awarding Certificates, Diplomas, and Degrees under the Multiple Entry and Exit system.

SWAYAM / MOOCs Courses

Students may earn credits through SWAYAM/MOOC courses as per the guidelines notified by HPU/UGC from time to time. These credits, once earned and transferred to the ABC, may be counted towards the total credit requirement subject to HPU regulations.

Attendance Requirements

A student must maintain a minimum of 75% attendance in each course to be eligible to appear in the End-Semester Examination.

Students with attendance below 75% in any course shall be detained from that course's End-Semester Examination as per HPU ordinances.

Genuine cases (medical or otherwise) of shortage of attendance shall be considered on merit as per HPU rules.

Promotion and Progression

Students shall be promoted from one semester to the next in accordance with HPU's Examination and Grading Ordinance/Notifications. However, a student can progress to the 4th Year (Semester VII & VIII) only after clearing all courses of the first three years (Semesters I to VI), applicable only in notified Four-Year Programme colleges.

SCHOLARSHIPS

A Number of Scholarships are available for the eligible and deserving students. Information regarding dates, eligibility conditions and procedure for applying for these scholarships will be notified on the college notice board from time to time. The students may apply online for these scholarships.

State Sponsored Scholarship Schemes.

- 1. IRDP Scholarship Scheme :** The Students who belong to IRDP families may apply for this scholarship with required documents. A sum of Rs. 1200/- per annum is provided as financial assistance.
- 2. Financial Assistance to the children of the armed Forces Personnel killed disabled during the different War/Operations:** Children of armed forces personnel killed/disabled in the different wars/operations are eligible for this assistance. Application proformas are available with District Sainik Welfare Board. A sum of Rs. 1200/- per annum is provided as financial assistance.
- 3. Indira Gandhi Utkrisht Chhatravritti Yojna for post plus two student:**
The Indira Gandhi Utkrisht Chhatravritti Yojna for meritorious students for the post plus two courses shall be awarded to 150 students @ Rs. 10,000/- p.a. per student purely on the basis of the merit and without any income ceiling. The Scholarship will also be awarded to ten toppers each from the merit list of 10+2 Arts, Science and Commerce, supplied by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala, provided they join any academic/professional stream. The scholarship will be renewed every year to the same number of students till they complete degree/course.
- 4. Kalpana Chawla Chhatravritti Yojna :**
This is state sponsored scheme started from the year 2012-13, Under this scheme the top 2000 meritorious girl students of 10+2 of all study groups i.e. Science, Arts and Commerce streams are awarded a scholarship of Rs.15000/- per student per annum based on passing ratio in each group as per the merit list supplied by HP Board of School Education, Dharamshala. The Scholarship will be renewed till the completion of Degree/Diploma/Certificate courses provided there is no failure.

Centrally Sponsored Scholarship Schemes

- 5. Post-Matriculation Scheme for SC/ST Students:** For students belonging to SC/ST category whose parents, annual income does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-
- 6. Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme to OBC Students:** The students belonging to OBC category are entitled for this scholarship if the annual income of their parents is up to Rs. 1,00,000/-
- 7. Maharishi Balmiki Chhatravritti Yojna :** The scholarship under this scheme is @ Rs.9000/- per year given to the Bonafide Himachali Girl Students belonging to Balmiki Families, engaged in unclean occupation. The concerned students must apply on prescribed proforma through their head of the school/college/institution along with balmiki certificate.
- 8. Merit-cum means Scholarship for Students belonging to the Minority Community (Centrally Sponsored Scheme) :** The annual income of the parents/guardians of the beneficiaries should not exceed Rs. 2.5 Lakhs from all sources and the student should not have secured less than 55% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination.
- 9. Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme Students belonging to Minority Community (Centrally Sponsored Scheme) :** The annual income of the parents/guardians of the beneficiaries should not exceed Rs.2 Lakh from all sources and the student should not have secured less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination. The students must have passed the examination from government/government-aided institutions.
- 10. Post matric Scholarship for students with disabilities :** This scheme is available to students with disabilities who are covered under the person with disabilities (Equal opportunity, protection of rights and full participation) Act, 1995. Scholarship under the scheme will be the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs. Government of India. Scholarship will be paid to the students whose parents/Guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- per annum.
- 11. Scholarship for Children of Mine Workers:** The scheme is sponsored by the Ministry of Labour and

Employment Government of India. Either of the parents of the student should be a beedi worker or a mine worker (Iron Ore/Manganese Ore/Chrome Ore Mines, Limestone/Dolomite or Mica Mines or a cine worker) for six months at least, this would also include contract laborers. Total Income of both the parents of the students from all sources should not exceed 10,000 p.m. including all allowance. The scholarship under this scheme is Rs. 3000/-per year.

Fee Concession

Half Fee Concession : One of the two or more real brother/sister studying in the lower class in the college will be eligible for 50% exemption in tuition fee.

Tuition Fee Concession : Himachali Bonafide Girls and Physically Challenged with a disability of more than 40%

CODE OF DISCIPLINE AND ACTS OF INDISCIPLINE

The students of the college and its surroundings including roads/approaches will be governed by the following disciplinary code :-

- Ragging(Zero Tolerance), "Ragging includes any type of physical and mental torture inflicted by an individual or group by words or conduct which creates an apprehension in the mind of the person that he/she cannot pursue his/her studies from any mental disturbance or torture created thereby." Ragging in and around the college campus or on roads/approaches leading thereto is a serious crime and strictly prohibited by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. A student found indulged in ragging directly or indirectly will be immediately expelled from the college under Rule 22, 17(a), (b), (c) of HP University Ordinance. Further, he/she will be immediately handed over to the police.
- Carrying/Bearing of College Identity Card is mandatory for every student.
- Misbehaving with Teachers/other staff will attract strict disciplinary actions.
- Playing songs/music on mobile including earphones in the college campus is strictly prohibited and will invite disciplinary actions.
- Holding of any meeting in the campus without prior permission of the college administration is an act of indiscipline and will invite disciplinary actions.
- Don't park your two wheelers out of the parking area specified for the students.
- Roaming in corridors and talking outside the class rooms in vacant period is unacceptable and will invite disciplinary actions.
- Damage to college property including defacement of wall, pasting of posters, damage to furniture etc is an act of indiscipline.
- Smoking & use of Ghutka etc tobacco product in and around college campus will attract immediate disciplinary actions.
- Students will not loiter aimlessly around the campus/roads. Students will leave the campus and its surroundings immediately after the end of classes.
- Don't bring outsiders and miscreants in the college campus failing which disciplinary proceeding will be initiated against both the parties.

Any student violating any of the above Codes of Discipline will be strictly dealt with. The college administration has the power to take any disciplinary actions as per law which may lead to special fine, suspension, rustication of students and handing over to the police with proper intimation to his/her parents

The Principal & members of the staff have power to take disciplinary action against student indulging in acts of indiscipline which may lead to fine, suspension, rustication or expulsion.

"Ragging includes any type of physical or mental torture inflicted by any individual or group, either by words or conduct which creates an apprehension in the mind of the person that he/she cannot pursue his/her studies free from any mental disturbance or torture created thereby. Any person who aids or abet such an action shall also be guilty of such ragging.

Ragging in and around the college/hostel campus or on roads/ approaches leading there to is strictly prohibited. If any student is found indulging in ragging, directly or indirectly, the college authorities shall be obliged under rule 22, 17 (a), (b) & (c) of HP. University to expel the guilty student (s) from the college/hostel.

B. Rules and Regulation & Loss of Books & Fine

Identity card and library card should be collected from the librarian as per the schedule notified by the librarian. A student must bring his/her library card to get the books issued in his/her name. Only two books are issued to a student at a time for a period of 14 days. Reference Books/Dictionaries/News Paper Periodicals will not be issued.

If the issued books are not returned by due date, a line at Rs. 1.00 per book per day will be charged. In case of loss of book. The student will have to replace the book with new one or pay actual price of the book plus 20% of the original prices as a fine amount.

Books returned in damaged condition will entail penalty as per rules. Failure to return the book or to pay the penalty imposed will entail the same procedure for recovery as in the case of recovery of Govt. property i.e. through the police or Deputy Commissioner.

पहचान पत्र व लाईब्ररी कार्ड, पुस्तकालय अध्यक्ष द्वारा जारी समय सारिणी के अनुसार ही प्राप्त किये जाने चाहिए। प्रत्येक छात्र केवल अपने कार्ड पर ही पुस्तकें ले सकता है। एक छात्र को एक समय में केवल दो ही पुस्तकें 14 दिन की अवधि के लिए जारी की जा सकती हैं। सन्दर्भ पुस्तकें, शब्दकोष, समाचार पत्र व सामयिक पत्रिकाएं विद्यार्थियों को जारी नहीं की जायेगी। यदि जारी की गई पुस्तकों को निर्धारित तिथि में वापिस नहीं किया जाता तो इसके पश्चात प्रतिदिन प्रति पुस्तक पर एक रुपये प्रतिदिन जुर्माना लगाया जाएगा। पुस्तक के खो जाने पर विद्यार्थी को नई पुस्तक खरीद कर देनी होगी अथवा पुस्तक का वास्तविक मूल्य तथा मूल्य के साथ पुस्तक की कीमत का 20 प्रतिशत अतिरिक्त शुल्क जुर्माने के रूप में जमा करना होगा। क्षतिग्रस्त अवस्था में लौटाई गई पुस्तकों पर नियमानुसार जुर्माना लगाया जाएगा। पुस्तकों को वापिस न करना व जुर्माना अदा न करने पर छात्र पर वसूली के लिए पुलिस विभाग व जिलाधीश के माध्यम से वही नियम लागू होंगे जो सरकारी सम्पत्ति की वसूली के लिए लागू होते हैं।

D. No. Dues Certificate & Refund of Library Security

All the issued books must be returned and library card be surrendered to the librarian before the annual examination. A No. Dues Certificate to this effect must be obtained from the librarian otherwise Admit card for Annual Exam will not be issued.

All the student can claim the refund of their library security within one year of leaving the college even if they leave the college without completing their course of study otherwise the security will stand lapsed.

Leave Rule

1. Students should get their leave application recommended by the teachers.
2. Leave up to 3 days will be sanctioned by the tutors.
3. Leave for more than three days will be sanctioned by the Principal
4. The Students will be marked absent during the leave period and the same will not be considered for calculating the lectures attended by him/her for determining his/her eligibility to appear in the University Examination, However in case leave is properly sanctioned, neither his/her name will be struck off from the rolls, nor any absence fine will be imposed.

Re-Admission

1. The Student absent for 5 days continuously from any class without proper sanctioning of leave by the concerned authority/principal, his/her name automatically will be struck off from the rolls.
 2. Readmission will be entertained on payment of readmission fee of Rs. 100/- within 7 days. After duly permitted by the Principal. After the expiry of 7 days, the student shall have to bear readmission fee of 200/- In addition to it, the principal may impose special fine depending upon the gravity of his/her absence.
 3. A student whose name has been struck off for the second time in session from any class will be ineligible for readmission to the class, but in exceptional cases, the Principal may grant special permission using his discretionary powers if he/she deems so.

 2. विद्यार्थी 7 दिनों के भीतर मूल्य 100 रुपये शुल्क के साथ प्राचार्य की विधिवत स्वीकृति प्राप्त करना अनिवार्य होगी। इसके अतिरिक्त अनुपस्थिति की प्रवृत्ति व गम्भीरता के आधार पर प्राचार्य द्वारा एक विशेष जुर्माना भी लगाया जा सकता है।
 3. असाधारण परिस्थितियों के अतिरिक्त यदि किसी विद्यार्थी का एक सत्र अथवा वर्ष में दूसरी बार नाम कट जाता है तो वह विद्यार्थी पुनः प्रवेश के लिए पात्र नहीं होगा। यद्यपि असाधारण परिस्थितियों में प्राचार्य अपनी विवेकाधीन शक्तियों का प्रयोग करके उसे पुनः प्रवेश के लिए विशेष अनुमति दे सकते हैं।

Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities.

Education is a very broad term and goes beyond the training of one's mind for acquiring textual knowledge. It is associated with other activities in order to see multi dimensional development of overall personality of a man. The college provides opportunity to our students through many co-curricular and other activities that help them to develop into a sound body and mind. National Service Scheme (NSS)

The College has half NSS unit. Enrollment In NSS is done in the beginning of the session in the month of August. Students have to apply as and when notified through notice board for enrollment in NSS.

Mentor Cell

The Students are encouraged to interact with their teachers regarding their problems which may be academic, non-academic or personal. Appropriate help and guidance is provided to cater the needs of students. It is also an essential and integral part of IQAC.

Collage Students Central Association (CSCA)

The Collage Student central association is formed every year as per the rules laid down by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla From Time to time. Presently the selection for various post of this association is done through merit i.e. indirect selection mode.

Parent Teacher Association (PTA)

To encourage community participation in education, Parent Teacher Association (PTA) under section 2.33 to 2.33.7 of the HP Education code, 2001 has been established. It is a non-political body for better co-ordination and interaction between parents and teachers for improvement of academic standards and infra-structural facilities of the college.
